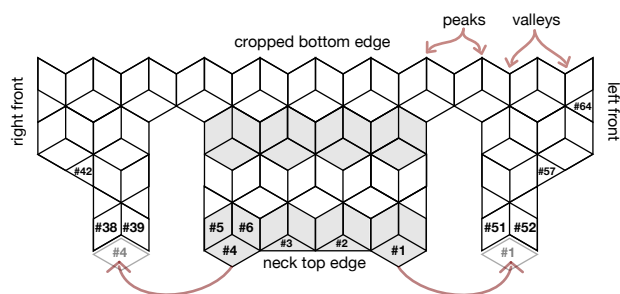




Addendum for Cropped Cubing Down Vest

Work as instructed to the end of page 1, completing ONE row of 20 side-diamond connecting the upper fronts and back. Notice that around the lower edge of the vest there are 11 “peaks” and 10 “valleys”.

With the public side facing, knit up 7 (8, 9) stitches in each selvage edge of the border diamonds (both stitch and row edges) **PLUS 1 additional stitch** at (or in) every “peak” and “valley” for a total of 161 (181, 201) stitches, turn.



Knit 1 row, turn.

Repeat [K1, M1, K6 (7, 8), Sl2tog, K1, PSSsO, K6 (7, 8), M1] across ending with K1, turn.

Knit 3 rows.

For a wider edge, add rows here in pattern;
1 increase/decrease row and 3 plain knit rows.

Repeat the increase/decrease row **BINDING OFF** all stitches (rs).

Continue with the finishing instructions beginning with the second paragraph. On the fronts and back neck ribbing, there are now 8 (not 11) diamonds / half-diamonds around to the mid point of the back neck and the “knit up” stitch count is 123 (141, 159). The final stitch count here is 131 (149, 167). The rest of the instructions remain the same.
